CHURCH FAMILY BARBECUE SUNDAY 22 JUNE

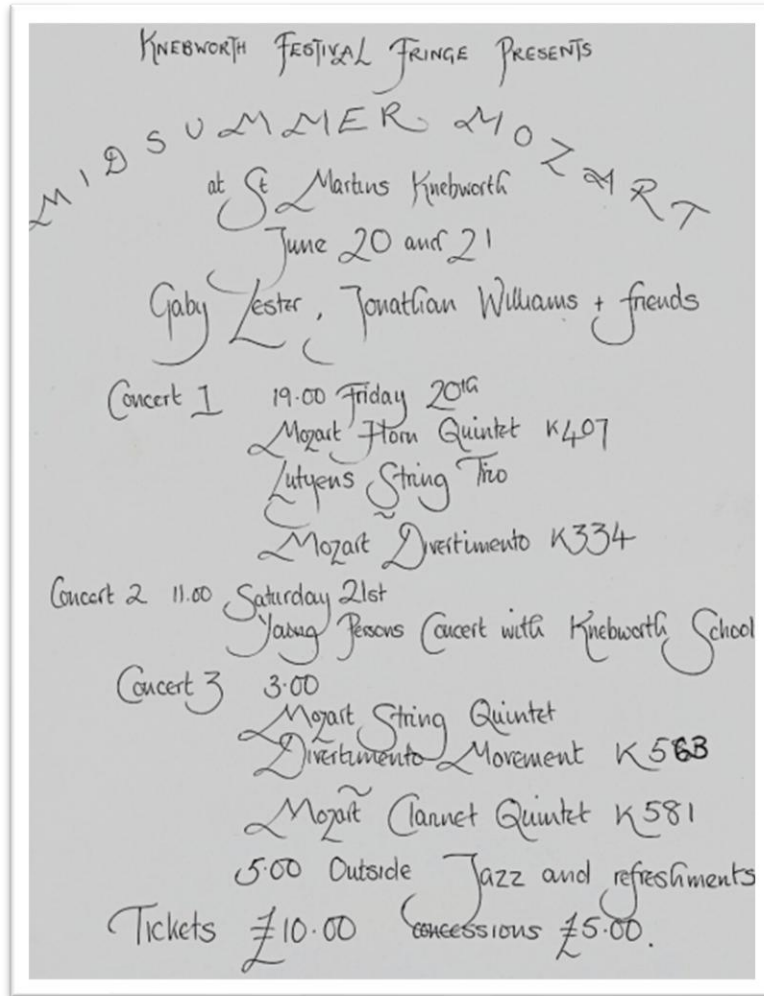
